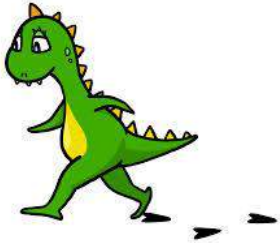


Tips for Chaperones

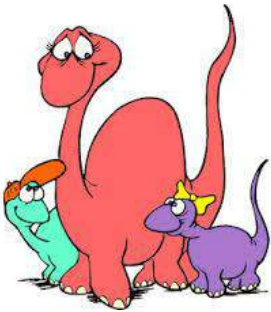
Here's how to have a great time at the Arizona Museum of Natural History!

Please share these rules with your group.



Walking feet

Please walk when inside the Museum. We have stairs and ramps where you could trip and fall if you are running, and the Museum's displays are NOT soft.



Stay together

One chaperone per ten kids is required. One chaperone per five kids is even better. Please keep your group together so no one gets lost.



Indoor voices

Please remember to keep your voice down when you are inside the Museum. We have some areas with high ceilings where noises echo, which can be distracting to other Museum visitors.



Don't touch – unless invited!

There are some things in the Museum that you can touch, and these will have labels that say you can touch them. Otherwise, please don't touch anything! The items on exhibit are often very fragile.



No food or drinks

Food and drinks are not allowed in the Museum galleries. You can leave a water bottle at the front desk if you need to, but please save your snacks for outside the Museum.
